In case you have limited access to internet you can apply for NFP fellowship using a hard copy application. Please let us know and we will mail you the application form.

The number of NFP/TP fellowships available is limited and admission to the course is on a competitive basis. Once you have applied for a NFP fellowship, you are registered in the SOL-system and you can check the status of your application online. The final selection of candidates will take place 16 weeks after the NFP fellowship application deadline. Shortly thereafter you will be informed by Nuffic on the outcome of your application.
