Language is a purely **human** and **non-instinctive** method of communicating ideas, emotions, and desires by means of **voluntarily produced symbols** (Sapir, 1921)

Language: Definition (2)

A language is a system of **arbitrary vocal symbols** by means of which a social group **co-operates** (Bloch & Trager, 1942)

Language: Definition (3)

 Language is the institution whereby humans communicate and interact with each other by means of habitually used oral-auditory arbitrary symbols (Hall, 1968) Language: Definition (4) Language is a set (finite or infinite) of sentences, each finite in length and constructed out of a finite set of elements (Chomsky, 1957).
